Weather Situation

A high pressure system over South Australia will move into the Tasman Sea later on Sunday. A cold front will approach western Victoria later on Sunday before weakening and moving through Bass Strait on Monday. A low pressure system looks likely to develop over western New South Wales later on Monday, moving eastwards to the north of Victoria on Tuesday and into the Tasman Sea on Tuesday night. A cold front will move across Victoria on Wednesday as a high pressure system strengthens south of Western Australia.

West Coast: SA-VIC Border to Cape Otway

Forecast for Saturday until midnight

Winds: West to northwesterly 20 to 25 knots. Seas: 1.5 to 2 metres. Swell: Southwesterly 5 metres.

Forecast for Sunday

Winds: Northwesterly 15 to 20 knots increasing to 20 to 25 knots around midday. Winds 15 to 25 knots by early evening. Seas: 1.5 to 2 metres. Swell: Southwesterly 4 to 5 metres.

Forecast for Monday

Winds: West to northwesterly 20 to 25 knots tending southwesterly 15 to 20 knots around dawn then tending south to southwesterly 10 to 15 knots during the morning. Seas: Up to 2 metres decreasing to below 1 metre during the afternoon. Swell: Southwesterly 4 metres.

Forecast for Tuesday

Winds: South to southeasterly 5 to 10 knots tending south to southwesterly during the morning then tending west to southwesterly 10 to 20 knots during the afternoon. Winds westerly up to 30 knots during the evening. Seas: Below 1 metre increasing up to 1.5 metres during the afternoon then increasing to 3 metres during the evening. Swell: Southwesterly 4 to 5 metres.

Central Coast: Cape Otway to Wilsons Promontory

Forecast for Saturday until midnight

Winds: West to northwesterly 10 to 20 knots. Seas: Up to 2 metres. Swell: Westerly 3 to 5 metres decreasing to 3 to 4 metres late this evening.

Forecast for Sunday

Winds: Northwesterly 15 to 20 knots decreasing to 10 to 15 knots during the afternoon then increasing to 15 to 20 knots by early evening. Seas: 1 to 1.5 metres. Swell: Westerly 2 to 4 metres.

Forecast for Monday

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Winds: West to northwesterly 15 to 25 knots tending west to southwesterly around dawn then becoming southwesterly 10 to 20 knots during the morning. Winds south to southwesterly 10 to 15 knots later in the evening. Seas: Up to 2 metres. Swell: Westerly 2 to 4 metres.

Forecast for Tuesday

Winds: South to southeasterly 5 to 10 knots tending west to southwesterly up to 15 knots during the afternoon then tending westerly 15 to 25 knots during the evening. Seas: Below 1 metre increasing to 1 to 2 metres during the evening. Swell: Westerly 2 to 4 metres.

Central Gippsland Coast: Wilsons Promontory to Lakes Entrance

Forecast for Saturday until midnight

Winds: Westerly 15 to 20 knots tending west to northwesterly 10 to 15 knots later in the evening. Seas: 1 to 2 metres. Swell: Southwesterly 0.5 to 1.5 metres.

Forecast for Sunday

Winds: Northwesterly 10 to 15 knots increasing to 10 to 20 knots by early evening. Seas: Up to 1.5 metres. Swell: Southwesterly 0.5 to 1.5 metres.

Forecast for Monday

Winds: Northwesterly 15 to 25 knots tending westerly 20 to 30 knots around dawn then tending west to southwesterly 20 to 25 knots during the morning. Winds southwesterly 15 to 20 knots later in the evening. Seas: 1 to 2 metres. Swell: Southwesterly 0.5 to 2 metres.

Forecast for Tuesday

Winds: Southwesterly 10 to 15 knots tending south to southwesterly up to 10 knots during the morning then tending westerly up to 15 knots during the evening. Seas: Below 1 metre. Swell: Southwesterly 1 to 2 metres.

East Gippsland Coast: Lakes Entrance to 60nm east of Gabo Island

Forecast for Saturday until midnight

Winds: West to southwesterly 15 to 20 knots tending westerly 10 to 15 knots later in the evening. Seas: 1 to 2 metres. Swell: Southwesterly 0.5 to 1.5 metres. Swell: Southerly 0.5 metres.

Forecast for Sunday

Winds: West to northwesterly 5 to 15 knots tending southwesterly up to 10 knots during the afternoon then tending north to northwesterly up to 15 knots by early evening. Seas: Up to 1.5 metres. Swell: Southwesterly 0.5 to 1.5 metres. Swell: Southerly 0.5 metres.

Forecast for Monday

Winds: West to northwesterly 10 to 20 knots tending westerly 15 to 25 knots around dawn then tending west to southwesterly 20 to 30 knots during the morning. Winds southwesterly 15 to 20 knots later in the evening. Seas: 1 to 2 metres increasing to 3 metres during the morning then decreasing to 2 metres by early evening. Swell: Southwesterly 0.5 to 1.5 metres. Swell: Southerly 0.5 metres.

Forecast for Tuesday

Winds: Southwesterly 10 to 20 knots tending southeast to southwesterly up to 10 knots during the morning then tending west to southwesterly during the evening. Seas: 1 to 1.5 metres decreasing to below 1 metre during the morning. Swell: Southwesterly 1 to 2 metres. Swell: Southerly about 1 metre increasing to 1.5 metres during the evening.
