Warnings

- 1. A Gale Warning has been issued for southern and western coastal waters between South East Cape and Sandy Cape.
- 2. Strong Wind Warnings have been issued for northwest, northeast and southeast coastal waters between Sandy Cape and Stanley, between northern tip of Flinders Island and Wineglass Bay, and between Tasman Island and South East Cape.
- 3. A Small Craft Wind Alert has been issued for the southwest and Central Plateau lakes.

Synoptic Situation

A deep low well south of the Bight will slowly move east over the next few days, with an associated cold front expected to cross Tasmania early Monday.

FAR NORTHWEST COAST, Sandy Cape to Stanley and King Island:

A Strong Wind Warning has been issued.

Saturday until midnight: West to northwest winds 15 to 25 knots. Seas 1.5 to 2.5 metres, abating. West to southwest swell 5 to 6 metres.

Sunday: Northwest winds 15 to 25 knots increasing to 20 to 30 knots during the afternoon and evening. Seas rising to 2 to 3 metres. Southwest swell 4 to 5 metres.

Monday: Northwest winds 20 to 30 knots tending southwest at similar speeds early, easing to 15 to 25 knots during the morning and shifting more southerly at 10-to 20-knots late. Seas 2-to-3 metres, abating. Southwest swell 5 to 6 metres.
